
Floral & Spice Focused



 Fresh, juicy fruits of wild cherry, red plum and raspberry are met with hints of cola, wet stone and dried herbs.


Artwork recognizes the original cherry orchard plantings on the vineyard property

 Dense and luscious black raspberry and boysenberry are complimented by sassafras, star anise and cinnamon bark.



 Mulberry, red plum with high toned hints of passionfruit comingle with rose petals and salted caramel for a luscious and lively wine.


Artwork depicts the pond at Hirschy Vineyard, a natural habitat for local wildlife

 Layered with dried blueberry, huckleberry and cassis find harmony with notes of sassafras and sweet tea.



 Black cherry, black currant and star anise blend with lily and hyacinth for a complex and heady, firmly structured wine.



 Bing cherry and ruby red grapefruit mingle with toasted spice notes of nutmeg and coriander. A velvet finish balances perfectly with bright acidity.



 Dried cherry and black plum skin mingle with black tea and hints of hibiscus, sweet clover and rosehip.


Original label showing the cold and wet days of winter pruning


Artwork shows typical profile of this basalt filled site

 Brambley fruits of black raspberry drive the profile with notes of dark chocolate, caramel and fresh turned earth.



 Exploding out of the glass with raspberry, huckleberry, and dark chocolate. Earthy notes of potting soil ground and round this silky wine.


