

2015 **ABBOTT CLAIM**


Vineyard Pinot Noir

"Firm and focused, this young wine has miles to go. It opens with bright raspberry and cherry fruit, then puts on bulk in the midpalate, adding lovely orange-peel highlights. Drinking well this young, it has the structure and depth to add many more layers over the next decade or longer. Drink now through 2030 and beyond." — P.G.

2015 **BONNIE JEAN**


Vineyard Pinot Noir

(Yamhill-Carlton AVA)

93 Points

"This young wine comes up quickly with strawberry fruit, ripe and dotted with white pepper. There are hints of parsley, and impressive midpalate concentration. With all of Ken Wright's wines, which are released quite young, the odds strongly favor additional development and improved complexity with another few years of bottle age."— P.G.

(Ribbon-Ridge AVA)

94 Points

"Bright red fruits, sappy acids and citrus highlights combine here. The supporting tannins are ripe and toasty, with a slightly grainy mouthfeel. Suggestions of coffee grounds add further interest to the finish, which expands gracefully as it breathes. This is a wine still pulling itself together and clearly built to expand and improve with further bottle age. Drink now through 2030." — P.G.

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


2015 **CANARY HILL**

Vineyard
Pinot Noir
(Eola-Amity Hills AVA)

94 Points

"Owned by the Wrights, this beautifully proportioned wine is supple and tasty, with berry, cherry and blue plum. The barrel aging adds a dusting of cocoa, and the tannins, ripe and still a bit stiff, add notes of ground coffee." — P.G.



2015 **CARTER**

Vineyard Pinot Noir

(Eola-Amity Hills AVA)

93 Points

"The Carter is a complex, even rugged wine, replete with layered flavors of herb, black cherry, cola and a touch of molasses. The tannins are as smooth as river rock, with appealing mineral and rock flavors following right behind." — P.G.

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2015 FREEDOM HILL


Vineyard Pinot Noir

(Willamette Valley AVA)

94 Points

"Lovely black-cherry fruit is the highlight here, with aromatics that elevate the fruit with hightoned intensity. The wine is cloaked with chocolate from barrel aging, and detailed with coffee grounds, graphite and loam" — P.G.

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2015 **GUADALUPE**


Vineyard Pinot Noir

"This remains tightly wound, but the deep flavors of black cherry and cassis suggest that once it unwraps it will add muscle and mass. Highlights of coffee and charred wood lead into an astringent finish with drying tannins." — P.G.

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


2015 **HIRSCHY**

New to Ken Wright Cellars in 2015, the Hirschy vineyard expresses vibrant red fruits such as mulberry and red plum with high toned hints of passionfruit—Flavors of rose petal and salted caramel with a lush texture.



2015 LATCHKEY


Vineyard Pinot Noir

"The Latchkey vineyard is shared with Cody Wright (of Purple Hands). Spicy cranberry, strawberry and raspberry fruit shines here, young and fresh and vibrant. It's snappy and sappy, with good grip and supporting acidity. It should drink best in the early 2020s,"—P.G.

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2015 **MCCRONE**


Vineyard Pinot Noir

"This is one of the top vineyard selections in this vintage, among a select group, notable for its outstanding focus and concentration. Still compact, its purple fruits are lightly spiced and deftly balanced; leaving little doubt that further improvement is just around the corner. Drink now through 2035."—P.G.

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2015 **SAVOYA**

Vineyard Pinot Noir

(Yamhill-Carlton AVA)

92 Points

"There's a dusty character to the tannins, which complement the tart pomegranate and raspberry fruit. It's already quite smooth, lightly toasty and finished with a dollop of cinnamon." — P.G.

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
2015 **SHEA**

"Pretty cherry candy flavors hold your attention here, balanced with perfectly ripened tannins. There's a light wash of milk chocolate and it finishes with cinnamon spice. In a stellar lineup of single-vineyard selections, the Shea is always surefire." —P.G.



2015 **TANAGER**Vineyard Pinot Noir

"This is round and pretty, and seems, at least for now, to be a bit more accessible than some of the more compact and ageworthy 2015 single-vineyard selections from Ken Wright. Drink it up soon, and enjoy the light touches of orange peel and cinnamon highlights." — P.G.
