

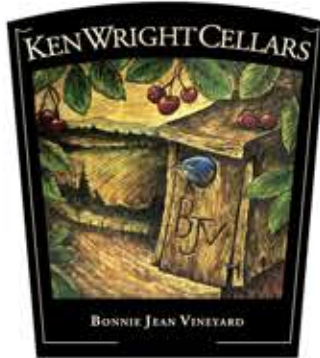

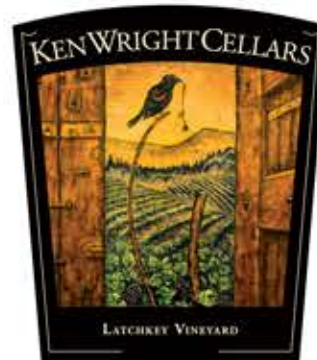

 property



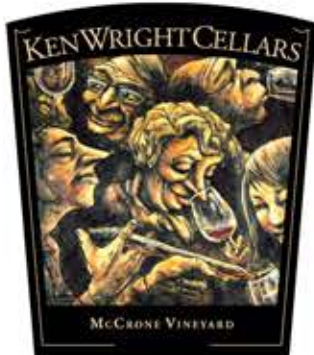
Bryce

 local wildlife



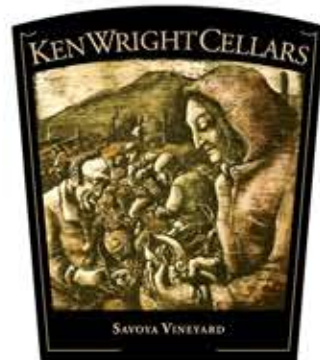
Latchkey

 through winery's 200 year-old doors



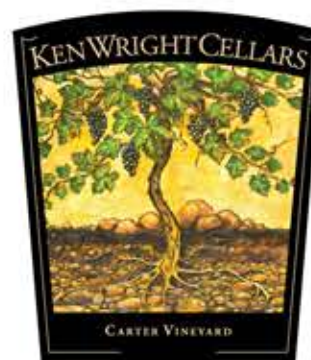
McCrone

 Artwork of our public barrel tasting



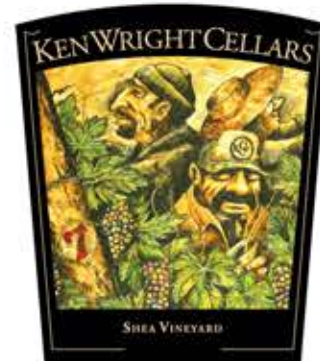
Canary Hill

 basalt filled site



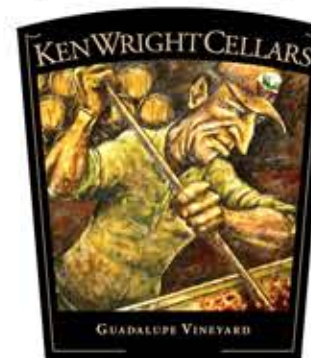

 Bright red fruits of raspberry and
 candied grapefruit meld with
 umami notes of shitake mushroom.
 Warming notes of garam masala
 play on the finish.
