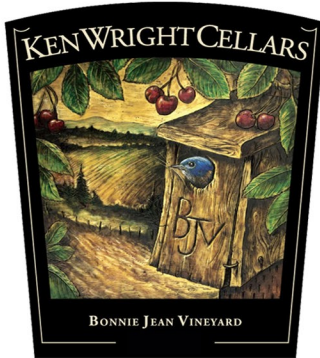


Abbott Claim

 Blanketed in a quilt of savory complexity, bright red fruits spar with earthen umami notes. Velvety tannins round the finish.

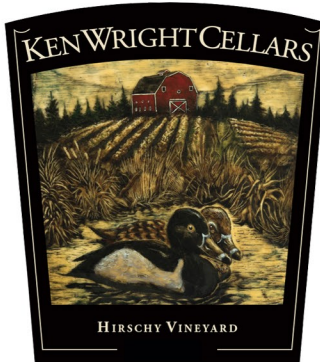

 Raspberry, red currant and bramble are met with a deeper note of mocha. Wisps of cherry blossom and vanilla round the palate.

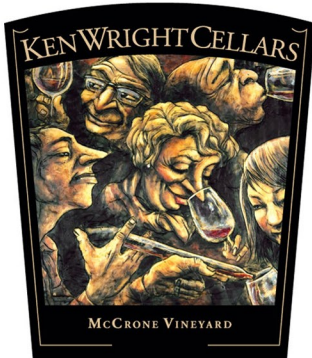
Artwork recognizes the original cherry orchard plantings on the vineyard property

 Dark, brooding black fruits coalesce with baking spices, umami undertones and violets.

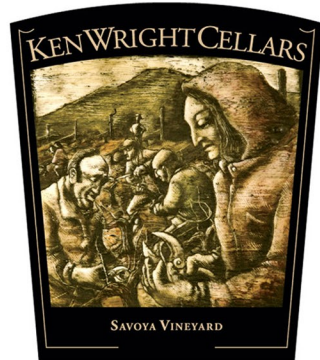
Artwork depicts the pond at Hirschy Vineyard, a natural habitat for local wildlife

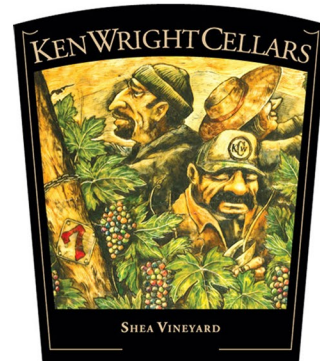

 Dried leaves and saddle leather deepen the aroma of black currant, cranberry and dried cherry. Rich on the palate with hints of cola.

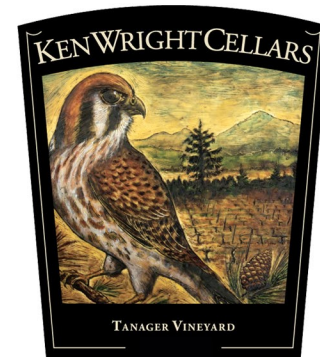
Original label showing the cold and wet days of winter pruning

Floral & Spice Focused
 Brambly fruits of marionberry and raspberry play with heady floral notes of lily and hyacinth. Brightness is balanced by ribbons of caramel, earth and maple.

Artwork depicts an American Kestrel which is used in our falconry program for vineyard pest control

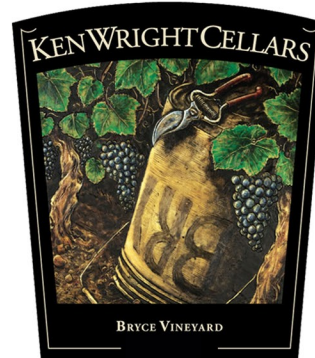

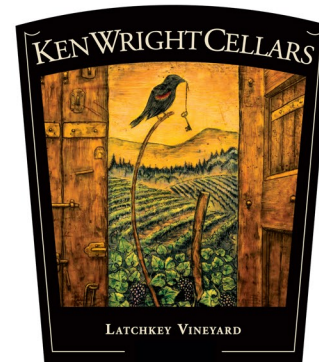

Floral & Spice Focused
 Crisp linen and alpine flowers dance with dried blueberry, huckleberry and sandalwood. A lively, balanced acidity elongates the finish.

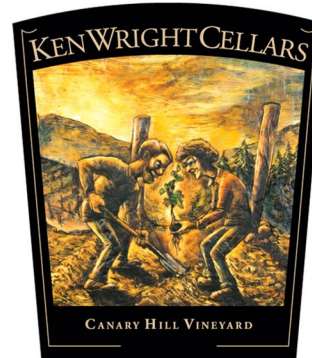
Artwork is an homage to the late Bryce Bagnall, the original owner

 500 elevation E-SE inclination

Fruit Focused
 Layered aromas of blueberry, apricot and strawberry compote meld with cinnamon stick and hints of nutmeg on the nose. Darker fruits emerge on the palate, met by a beautifully bright and vibrant finish.

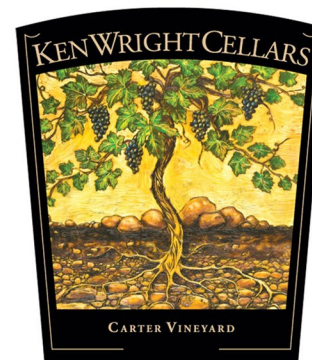

 Juicy fruits of boysenberry and black cherry dance with tropical hints of guava and orange peel for a lively, luscious mouthfeel and a silken finish.

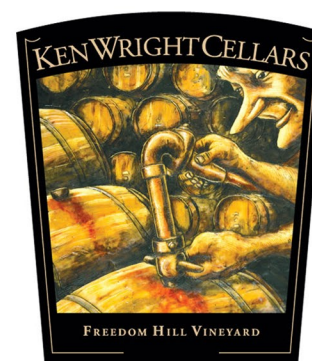

Fruit Focused
 Dense, darker fruit of blackberry and loganberry mingle with turned earth, hints of saffron and violets. Lush on the palate with beautifully balanced structure.

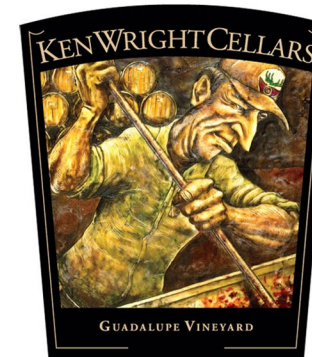
Artwork shows typical profile of this basalt filled site
