



# 2021 BONNIE JEAN VINEYARD PINOT NOIR

**YEAR PLANTED & ACREAGE:**

2010, 2014 and 2020 | 22 acres planted

**SPACING:** 7 X 5 ft. , 1,244 vines/acre

**ELEVATION & ASPECT:** 400-450 ft, E-SE

**CLONES & ROOTSTOCK:** 777, Wadenswil, 667, Pommard, 76 & 177. All clones planted on Riparia Gloire.

**MOTHER ROCK:** Ancient Marine Sediments

**SOIL SERIES:** Willakenzie and Wellsdale

**AVA:** Yamhill-Carlton



**TASTING NOTES:** Savory, floral and spice focused—Flavors of huckleberry and red plum are deepened by notes of fresh honey, cocoa nibs and cola. Soft and silky tannins on the finish.

**VINTAGE:** Our crop level averaged just under three tons this year which was perfect for the accumulated heat we experienced over the growing season. Disease was nonexistent with the dry conditions of the summer months and the fermentation's proceeded perfectly with nary a one going "sideways" on us. The wine is rich, expressive, detailed and deeply colored.

**FARMING:** Organic certified, nutrition-based farming

**AGING REGIME:** 10-11 months in 20% new French oak barrels

**ALCOHOL:** 12.8%      **pH:** 3.59      **TA:** 4.9 g/L
