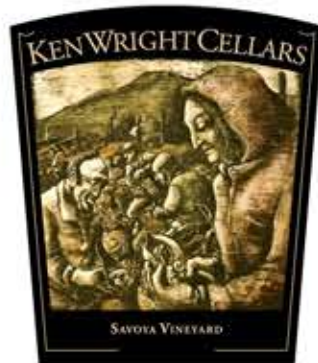

Artwork depicts the pond at Hirschy Vineyard, a natural habitat for local wildlife



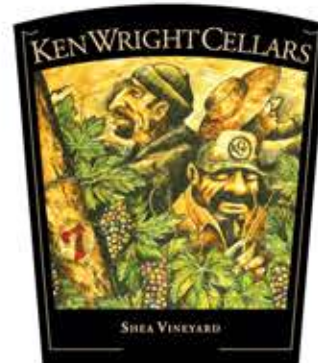

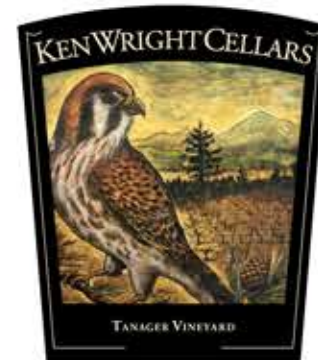

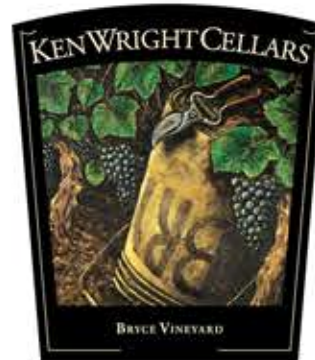

 300 elevation S-SE inclination
Certified Organic
Savory, floral and spice focused—Blackberry, cherry cola and dried strawberry are rounded by hints of vanilla bean, wet stone and gardenia. Baking spices and refined tannins linger on the finish.

Artwork is an homage to the late Bryce Bagnall, the original owner



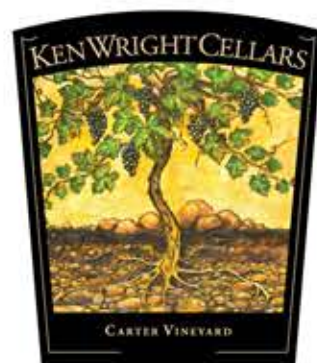
Latchkey

 500 elevation E-SE inclination
Red fruit focused—A core of blueberry, strawberry and black plum are lush on the palate. Notes of white flowers, honeycomb and cedar mingle in a supple, complex finish.

Blue and black fruit focused—Brilliant fruits of Bing cherry, blackberry and quince are surrounded by floral notes of lilac and hibiscus. Silken and suave on the palate with a vibrant acidity.

Savory, floral and spice focused—Bright tones of tart cherry and passionfruit on the nose blend with sumptuous black raspberry, turned earth and hints of fresh honey. Supple and lithe on the palate with a lingering finish.

Savory, floral and spice focused—Inviting fruits of red raspberry and blueberry blend with spice and earthen notes of leather, forest floor, cinnamon and graham cracker. Structured and dense on the palate.
