TASTING NOTES: Our Canary Hill Rosé exhibits lively notes of fresh strawberry, watermelon, rhubarb, and hints of citrus blossom. Rich and texturally pleasing on the palate.

VINTAGE: 2022 was a miraculous vintage for Ken Wright Cellars. Mother Nature never ceases to amaze us. We had record low temperatures in mid-April during bud break, causing damage and threatening whether we would have any fruit to harvest. A late but very fertile flowering season in July gave us hope for the season again, but we knew harvest would be late into the fall with potential for turbulent weather. To our surprise we had an absolutely stunning October.
